**P. 13-17** The Board is being asked to approve a resolution for a routine renewal of our Operating Millage (Non-Homestead). The State of Michigan expects all public school districts to levy 17.8308 mills. Failure to do so, results in the State withholding the equivalent amount from our per pupil foundation allowance. This renewal is only levied against businesses and secondary residences. Primary homeowners are not affected.

The Board is being asked to approve an agreement with Compass Group USA, Inc. (Chartwells), which provides food service management for CAPS' cafeterias. The Michigan Department of Education has approved this vendor choice. They were also the lowest bid. The contract is for a period of one year beginning July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025, with up to (4) four one year renewals.

The Band Department would like the Board to approve the purchase of band instruments. The instruments will be bond purchases not to exceed \$55,000.
