**What is 98c?**

- Part of PA (public act) 144 of 2022 (MCL 388.1698c) Michigan
- Part of Governors Emergency Education Relief (GEER) and part of the federal Elementary And Secondary Emergency Relief plan (ESSER II)

**Plan requirements:**

Must address learning loss

Must be presented to the board in a public meeting

Must be posted on the LEA website by October 30,2022

Must report on progress by August 2023

**Plan for Coopersville Area Public Schools**

- CAPS will use funds to enhance evidence based instructional practices in tier 1 instruction and Tier 2.
- CAPS will use funds to support where identified student tier 3 supports in behavior. Also, specialized staff needed to support students in tier 2 or 3.
- Primary use of funds will be to support smaller class size to improve student achievement, and access to Tier 1 instruction. CAPS will use a formula based on the subgroups to identify all students behind in academic achievement.
- CAPS 98c budget includes a formula as recommended by ESSER II. Budget is based on this formula.
- Program measures are based on NWEA, local assessment, M-STEP, and other diagnostic measures used in reading and math.
- Monitoring will consist of District all Schools reports.
- CAPS will comply with all reporting requirements, both state and federal.
