1. What was the total amount of the district's Section 31a allocation for the 2025-26 school year?

\$1,802,780.87

2. Describe the district's methodology and decision-making for distributing Section 31a At-risk grant funds to target the buildings with the highest needs.

The district uses a data-driven approach through our Multi-Tiered System of Supports team to determine academic and behavioral needs. Funding is allocated to districts based on a formula that includes students eligible for free/reduced-price lunch and the percentage of students scoring below proficient on state and local benchmark assessments. (NWEA, M-Step, PSAT, SAT) Funding to the buildings is based on needs to ensure resources like intervention specialists are concentrated where the academic and behavioral needs are highest.

3. What evidence-based interventions and services were implemented with the Section 31a At-risk grant funds during the 2025-26 grant cycle?

During the 2025-2026 school year, Section 31a funds were used to implement the following high-impact, evidence-based practices:

- K-5 Tier 2 and Tier 3 Reading Intervention: small group reading intervention utilizing Differentiated Reading Instruction, Fluency, or REWARDS lessons
- K-5 Tier 2 and Tier 3 Math Intervention: small group math intervention utilizing BRIDGES lessons
- Behavioral and Mental Health Support: funding for school social workers to provide interventions and behavioral support
- Secondary Academic Support: funding for certified teaching staff to support core instruction and credit recovery

4. In what ways has the district collected feedback from parents or legal guardians on these interventions and services provided this year?

Feedback collection for the 2025-2026 school year was captured informally during individual parent conferences, IEP meetings, and 504 meetings.

Starting in Fall 2026, a feedback form will be available on our district website and in the main office of every school building.
