Bronco Families:

As of August 29, 2022, the current protocol below from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services regarding COVID-19 and is also followed by Coopersville Area Public Schools:

- If an individual tests positive for COVID-19, they are to be isolated at home for 5 days (day "0" is the day symptoms began or day the test was taken for those without symptoms). If symptoms have improved or no symptoms developed, the student may return to school after day 5 wearing a well-fitting mask. The student is to wear a mask through day 10. If the student is unable to wear a mask, the student should isolate at home through day 10.
- If a student is exposed to someone with COVID-19, it is recommended that they monitor their symptoms for 10 days. If symptoms develop, it is recommended that they take a COVID test. Students who are close contacts are not required to quarantine.
